

ORDINANCE NO. O-24-03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 905.03(d) OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON; AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, this amendment to the Codified Ordinance is necessary to properly address the needs of the Village of Clinton;

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the amended bonding and related policies are necessary and in the best interest of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Clinton, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That Section 905.03(d) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Clinton be amended and provide as follows:

A bond for work must be submitted by the contractor. **A contractor can apply for either an annual or project based bond as provided herein. The bond form must be processed and signed by the contractor's insurance company. The An annual bond will apply to permits issued to the same contractor for the current calendar year for work within the Municipality. The annual bond shall run from January 1 to December of the current calendar year. (If application for permit occurs after October 1, and applicant does not have a current bond on file, the bond will run through December 31 of the next calendar year.) The bond form must be processed and signed by the contractor's insurance company. The annual bond shall be in the amount of \$50,000. An individual \$1,000,000.00 project bond in the amount of \$5,000 is required for individual right-of-way projects replacement. For all other street, sidewalk, or earthwork projects, the Street Commissioner and Engineer, together, shall will determine the necessary amount for a bond. In every instance under this subpart, the Street Commissioner and Engineer, together, may waive the bond requirement.**

Section 2: To the extent they conflict, all prior resolutions and ordinances that relate to this measure are hereby repealed and rescinded.

Section 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the Village of Clinton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective in order to provide for the immediate legal services provided for herein, which are necessary to preserve and protect the legal interests of the Village. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
