

RESOLUTION NO. R-24-07

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF THE
SUMMIT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, FOR THE EXECUTIVE
DEPARTMENT OF LAW, INSURANCE AND RISK MANAGEMENT – DIVISION OF
PUBLIC SAFETY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS; the Federal Emergency Management Agency (“FEMA”) has established rules and regulations under the United States Code of Federal Regulations, Title 44, Section 201.6, as authorized by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, requiring local governments to have a mitigation plan (“Plan”) approved pursuant to the aforementioned section in order to receive Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grants; and,

WHEREAS; the Summit County Emergency Management Agency (“SCEMA”) is responsible to update the Plan every five years, and has updated the same; and,

WHEREAS; the updated Plan was reviewed by local planning agencies, police and fire chiefs, and the County Engineer, and was ultimately approved by the Summit County Emergency Management Executive Committee; and,

WHEREAS; the updated Plan was subsequently approved by the Ohio Emergency Management Agency (“OEMA”) and FEMA; and,

WHEREAS; the updated Plan must now be adopted by the Village of Clinton and this Council; and,

WHEREAS, following adoption by the County and municipalities, the Resolutions adopting the updated Plan are forwarded to OEMA and FEMA; and,

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village of Clinton to approve and adopt the aforementioned mitigation plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Clinton, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That this Council hereby adopts and agrees to participate in the County of Summit Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, which is on file in the Office of the Director, County of Summit Emergency Management Agency.

Section 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the

public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Clinton, and for the further reason to immediately approve and adopt the Summit County Hazard Mitigation Plan to establish eligibility of hazard mitigation grant funding.

Section 5: Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


