

**RESOLUTION NO. R-24-04**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES  
AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
DECEMBER 31, 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**SECTION 1:** BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Clinton, State of Ohio, this Council finds and determines it is necessary to amend annual appropriations to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024.

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

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**SECTION 2:** The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to issue warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law, ordinance or resolution. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for the purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

**SECTION 3:** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an opening meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4:** That this Council finds the adoption of this Resolution is an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village, and shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately upon after its passage.
