

**RESOLUTION NO. R-24-16**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON TO  
ENTER INTO A DISPATCH SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE SOUTH SUMMIT  
COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS;** the South Summit Council of Governments ("SSCOG") currently provides dispatch and other related services; and,

**WHEREAS;** the Village of Clinton desires to contract with the SSCOg for such services; and,

**WHEREAS;** both the SSCOg and the Village of Clinton are desirous of establishing a dispatch services contract; and,

**WHEREAS;** the Village of Clinton recognizes that this service contract will enable the Village to spend its resources in a manageable way and with certainty; and,

**WHEREAS;** this agreement will allow the Village of Clinton to immediately preserve the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of its taxpayers and the inhabitants thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Clinton, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

**Section 1:** That the Mayor of the Village of Clinton is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the South Summit Council of Governments regarding dispatch and related services, in a form similar to the one attached hereto as Exhibit "A."


**Section 2:** That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to sign all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.


**Section 3:** That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.


**Section 4:** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and to allow for the timely transition of dispatch services and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
